

Celebration for Education

on November 20

The Milton Foundation for Education will host the 6th Annual Celebration for Education on Saturday, November 20, 2004 at Lombardo's in Randolph. This event is the premier fundraiser for the Foundation, a non-profit group that supports the educational programs of the Milton Public Schools.

The 2004 Celebration, which is focused on raising funds to supplement the town's World Languages Program, will bring to a close another rewarding year for the Foundation, which has worked closely in partnership with the Glover school, its teachers and families.

During the past year, Glover Elementary School teachers received approximately \$3,500 in funding through the two rounds of the Foundation's competitive grants program. In addition, Glover will receive nearly \$13,000 in fitness equipment and health education materials as a result of last year's Celebration.

The Sam Cichello Memorial Fund, which is administered by the Foundation, dedicated the proceeds from the annual Monster Dash road race to fund part of the cost for the first science enrichment specialist in the elementary grades in two years. Maryellen McDermott will be working with 3rd, 4th and 5th graders.

Last spring, second-grade teacher Linda Griffin was recognized as one of the town's Outstanding Teachers of the Year.

"We are grateful for the many generous parents at Glover and throughout Milton who have supported the Foundation's efforts to help our teachers provide innovative and effective educational programs for our students," said Foundation President and Glover mom Carol Rosner. "Milton is fast becoming known as an 'education town' and that is a tribute to all the work of our educators, families, business partners and friends."
